Notice of Proposals and Hearing

Please take notice that the Berkeley County Council shall hold a hearing and take evidence on the proposed creation of a public service district for the purpose of providing stormwater services and water quality management in the entirety of Berkeley County, excluding the City of Martinsburg, and proposed simultaneous reduction in the responsibilities of the Berkeley County Public Service Sewer District for the purpose of excluding any and all responsibilities for stormwater services and water quality management therefrom, on the 1st day of March, 2018, beginning at 11:30 o'clock a.m. and, again, on the same date, beginning at 6:30 o'clock p.m. in the County Council Chambers located at Suite 205, 400 West Stephen Street, Martinsburg, West Virginia 25401. If approved, these proposals shall require the Berkeley County Public Service Sewer District to transfer all relevant permits, assets, liabilities and other responsibilities to the new stormwater public service district.

All persons who are residing in or owning or having any interest in property in Berkeley County, excluding the City of Martinsburg, and all customers of the Berkeley County Public Service Sewer District, may be heard for or against the proposals.
