### **Indictments Returned on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 By the February, 2018 Term of the Berkeley County Grand Jury**

MARTINSBURG, WV – On February 21, 2018, the February 2018 term of Grand Jury reconvened at the Berkeley County Judicial Center. On Wednesday, the Grand Jury returned indictments against the following individuals, who are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty:

MICHAEL ANTHONY ARRINGTON, JR., age 33, of Lanham, Maryland, was charged with two counts of Attempted Murder and ten counts of Wanton Endangerment.

MARK LYNNARD BLUE, age 32, of Baltimore, Maryland, was charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin, Possession with Intent to Deliver Crack Cocaine, Possession with Intent to Deliver Synthetic Marijuana, Person Prohibited from Possessing a Firearm, two counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance, two counts of Obstructing an Officer, Escape, Possession of/Receiving Stolen Property, two counts of Possession of a Telecommunications Device in Jail, and Possession of a Controlled Substance in Jail.

BRANDON DALE FRENCH, age 34, of no fixed address, was charged with Conspiracy to Possess a Controlled Substance in Jail, two counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance in Jail, and Attempted Delivery of Buprenorphine.

MICHAEL D. GOLDBERG, age 53, of Falling Waters, West Virginia, was charged with forty-six counts of Fraudulent Use of an Access Device, two counts of Felony Fraudulent Scheme, and Conspiracy to Commit Fraudulent Schemes.

MICHAEL EMANUAL GRAHAM, age 39, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with two counts of Delivery of Crack Cocaine.

ASIA EUGENE JACKSON, JR., age 26, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with three counts of Delivery of Heroin, Delivery of Crack Cocaine, and Conspiracy to Deliver Crack Cocaine.

KIMBERLY A. KELLEY, age 33, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Delivery of Heroin Within 1,000 Feet of a School or College and Conspiracy to Deliver Heroin.

TIMOTHY LANE KELLEY, age 33, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Delivery of Heroin and two counts of Delivery of Heroin Within 1,000 Feet of a School or College.

JOSEPH ALLEN KILLIAN, age 36, of no fixed address, was charged with Conspiracy to Possess a Controlled Substance in Jail.

TERRY ALLEN KING, age 29, of no fixed address, was charged with two counts of Possession of a Weapon in Jail, Attempted Escape, and Felony Destruction of Property.

LENNE LARUE, III, age 33, of Waynesboro, Pennsylvania, was charged with Manufacture of Marijuana, Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana, Transport a Controlled Substance into the State, and Possession of Heroin.

LATEEF J. MCGANN, age 27, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with three counts of Malicious Wounding.

ANDRE EUGENE NICHOLAS, age 52, of Ranson, West Virginia, was charged with three counts of Delivery of Heroin.

MARY MAY POIST, age 50, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Shoplifting, Third Offense.

BRANDI MICHELLE RITTER, age 34, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Conspiracy to Deliver Heroin and Delivery of Heroin.

STEPHANIE RENEE SHANHOLTZ, age 33, of no fixed address, was charged with Malicious Assault on a Correctional Employee.

MATTHEW DEAN SMITH, age 39, of Great Cacapon, West Virginia, was charged with Attempted Murder, Wanton Endangerment, Use of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony, Possession with Intent to Deliver Methamphetamine, and Driving While License Suspended.

TIMOTHY D. STEWART, SR., age 59, of Charles Town, West Virginia, was charged with two counts of Conspiracy to Distribute Heroin and two counts of Distribution of Heroin.

LARRY CURTIS SWANSON, age 68, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with two counts of Distribution of Heroin.

Superseding indictments were also presented to the February 2018 term of Grand Jury. A superseding indictment is an indictment that takes the place of, takes precedence over, or replaces a previously obtained indictment. Superseding indictments were issued against the following individuals, who are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty:

AUSTIN STEVEN HESS, age 24, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Robbery First Degree.

BRITTANY ROSE REUILLE, age 27, of Hedgesville, West Virginia, was charged with three counts of Gross Child Neglect Creating Substantial Risk of Serious Bodily Injury.

JUSTIN WAYNE ROSS, age 29, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with three counts of Second Offense Felony Failure to Register as a Sex Offender.
