Indictments Returned By the May, 2020 Term of the Berkeley County Grand Jury

MARTINSBURG, WV – Berkeley County Prosecuting Attorney Catie Wilkes Delligatti announces that on Tuesday, June 23, 2020, the May 2020 term of Grand Jury was convened at the Berkeley County Judicial Center. The convening of the Grand Jury was delayed by Order of the Chief Judge of the 23rd Judicial Circuit and the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals due to concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and to ensure proceedings could be conducted as safely as possible. Grand Jury deliberations lasted through Thursday. The Grand Jury returned a total of sixty-five (65) indictments.

Indictments were returned against the following individuals for the following counts.

LUIS EDUARDO AGUILAR, 24, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with four counts of Sexual Abuse by Parent, Guardian or Custodian, or Person in a Position of Trust, two counts of Sexual Assault in the First Degree, and two counts of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree.

HAROLD EDGAR ALEXANDER, 56, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Malicious Wounding.

DEVAY O'BRIAN BANKS, 22, of Bunker Hill, West Virginia, was charged with Conspiracy to Uttering a Counterfeit Check. In a separate Indictment, BANKS was charged with Uttering a Counterfeit Check, Conspiracy to Uttering a Counterfeit Check, and two counts of Receiving Stolen Property.

CHARLES JEFFERSON BARKER, 35, of Berkeley Springs, West Virginia, was charged with Battery on a Government Representative.

CODY WADE BRAITHWAITE, 33, of Winchester, Virginia, was charged with DUI Resulting in Death, Fleeing From a Law Enforcement Officer While DUI, Fleeing From a Law Enforcement Officer with Reckless Indifference, Leaving the Scene of an Accident Resulting in Death, Flee from Law Enforcement Officer by Means Other than Use of Vehicle, and three counts of Person Prohibited from Possession of a Firearm.

MARY ELIZABETH CARTER, 26, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Attempted Murder, Attempted Malicious Assault, Conspiracy to Commit Malicious Assault, Wanton Endangerment, and Conspiracy to Commit Wanton Endangerment.

SHEILA JEAN COOK, 43 of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Conspiracy to Violate Possession of Contraband in Jail by an Inmate, and Conspiracy to Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine.

MATTHEW TODD CRIM, 28, of Bunker Hill, West Virginia, was charged with Burglary, Petit Larceny, and Misdemeanor Destruction of Property.

JOSHUA EARL CUPP, 33, of Falling Waters, West Virginia, was charged with Conspiracy to Violate Possession of Contraband in Jail by an Inmate, Conspiracy to Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine, Attempted Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine, and Attempted Possession of a Controlled Substance in Jail by an Inmate.

TYREE AARON ELDRIDGE, 34, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Distribution of Fentanyl, Conspiracy to Distribute Fentanyl, Possession with Intent to Distribute Fentanyl, Possession with Intent to Distribute Crack Cocaine, and Possession with Intent to Distribute Synthetic Cathinones.

All charges contained in the above-referenced indictments are merely accusations and not evidence of guilt. Each defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
