



**GLASS BOTTLE AND JAR RECYCLING:** In 2017, the Berkeley County Recycling Program collected and shipped out 495,500 pounds of bottles and jars for recycling. This number represented an incredible 36% increase in weight when compared to 2016. The glass is shipped to a large processor in Pennsylvania, called Carry All Products, where it is further processed much like a recipe to prepare the glass to be used in manufacturing. To help keep glass recycling healthy in Berkeley County, please remember to follow the simple rules needed for successful recycling. Please make sure the jars and bottles are empty and cleaned. Once at the recycling centers, separate the jars and bottles by colors. Do not include anything other than jars and bottles. Coffee mugs, window glass, mirrors and ceramics are NOT acceptable and could cause an entire tractor trailer load to be rejected. If you have any questions, feel free to contact our office.
