ADDENDUM #1

Section III A-1-B

Section III A-1-B(ii)

Vests must include outer armor carriers. The carrier must be equipped with the following features:

- a. Durable Water Repellent (DWR) Microfiber outer shell construction;
- b. Self-Suspending Ballistic System that keeps the ballistic panels from sagging and bunching in the bottom of the carrier;
- c. Ergonomically designed for a tailored fit, appearance and minimum visibility;
- d. A material that provides significant added protection against Taser® or electroshock weapons;
- e. Adjustable side closure straps for a minimum 6-way adjustability;
- f. A minimum of two front vest storage pockets
- g. Color: Black

Section III A-1-B(iii)

The body armor protective panels will be constructed from a blend of the most current ballistic materials to provide flexibility, light weight, and strength. Protective panels containing Zylon will not be accepted.

Section III A-1-C	Bullet resistant soft body armor comes in various packages. NIJ requires all level 3A's to offer the same stopping power. All vests must be of a medium weight not to exceed 1.16lbs per SF.
Section III A-1-D	Must be approved vest via the National Institute of Justice (NIJ). NIJ Compliance Testing Program requirements for production armor panel labels must be met.
Section IV B-1	All submissions shall include an NIJ Certification Letter, drawings, diagrams, technical specifications, and warranty certifications.
Section XI B	A contract award will be made contingent upon receiving the grant award, with an estimated date of September 30, 2018. The contract will be awarded to the Company whose proposal, conforming to this request, will be the most advantageous to Berkeley County.
