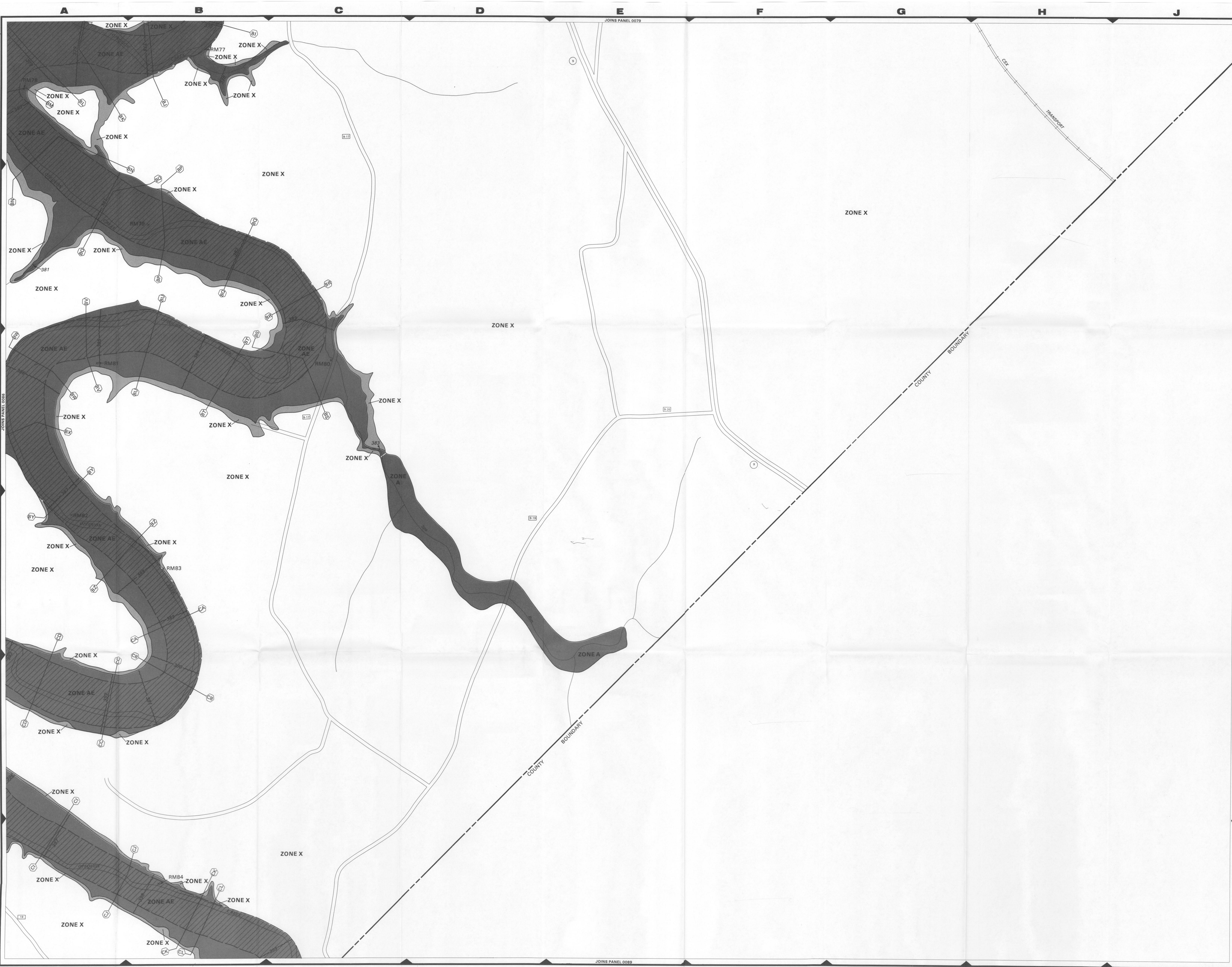




LEGEND

SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS IN UNIFORM FLOOD PLAIN BY 100-YEAR FLOOD

- ZONE A** No base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AE** Base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AH** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usual ponding); base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AO** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usual flow on sloping terrain); areas determined. For areas of alluvial flow, velocities also determined.
- ZONE A99** To be protected from 100-year Federal flood protection system construction; no base elevations determined.
- ZONE V** Coastal flood with velocity hazard action; no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE VE** Coastal flood with velocity hazard action; base flood elevations determined.

OTHER FLOOD AREAS

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly local drainage sources of small size, or all planimetric features outside flood hazard areas. The coastal flooding elevations shown may differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were computed on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show. Floodway widths are provided in the Flood Insurance Study Report.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only landward of 0.0 NAD 83. Coastal base flood elevations shown on this map include the effects of wave action.

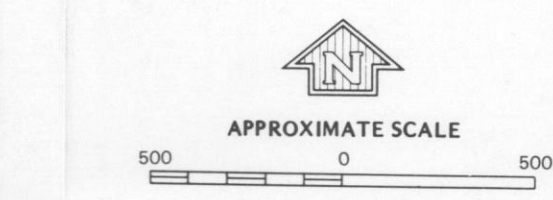
