

The WV Department of Homeland Security has established the See Something, Send Something app as part of the Governor's school safety initiative and general community awareness.

The **West Virginia Department of Homeland Security** has partnered with My Mobile Witness to implement the reporting system. All tips/reports will be monitored by the West Virginia Emergency Management Division's Watch Center 24/7. The Watch Center will forward reports to the appropriate agencies.

Community members can use the App to report "*Crime/Suspicious Activity*" or "*School Threat or Safety Issues*." Photos and videos can be included and tips can be submitted anonymously. Users can also request help for "Suicide or Addiction." Reporting suspicious, criminal, threatening, or terrorist activity is an important part of community safety.

Use the appropriate QR Code for your mobile device and follow the steps to get the App set-up.







