MARTINSBURG, WV – Berkeley County Prosecuting Attorney Catie Wilkes Delligatti announces today that a Berkeley County jury found Chris Miller, 37, of Hedgesville, WV, guilty of Delivery of Heroin and Conspiracy to Deliver Heroin. Miller faces a penalty of incarceration for not less than one (1) year nor more than fifteen (15) years, or a fine of not more than \$25,000, or both for the charge of Delivery of Heroin. For the charge of Conspiracy, Miller faces a penalty of incarceration for not less than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years, or a fine of not more than \$10,000, or in the discretion of the court, both. A Sentencing hearing has been scheduled in September. The two day trial was held before the Honorable Judge Michael D. Lorensen of the 23rd Judicial Circuit.

This matter was investigated by the Eastern Panhandle Drug & Violent Crime Task Force. This case was prosecuted by Berkeley County Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys Lydia Lehman and Christopher Barnhart.
