MARTINSBURG, WV – Berkeley County Prosecuting Attorney Catie Wilkes Delligatti announces today that a Berkeley County jury found KATIE MARIA ANGLE, 36, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, guilty of the felony offense of Possession with Intent to Deliver Alprazolam (more commonly known as Xanax) and the misdemeanor offense of Conspiracy to Commit Possession of Alprazolam arising from an incident on April 9, 2017. ANGLE faces a penalty of incarceration of not less than one (1) year nor more than three (3) years in prison, or a fine of not more than \$10,000, or both, for the conviction of Possession with Intent to Deliver Alprazolam; and a penalty of incarceration of not more than twelve (12) months in jail, or a fine of not more than \$1,000, or both, for the conviction of misdemeanor Conspiracy to Commit Possession of Alprazolam. Upon the return of the jury's verdicts, the Defendant was remanded to the custody of the Eastern Regional Jail to await sentencing. A sentencing hearing is scheduled for June 3, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. The two-day trial was held before the Honorable Judge Michael D. Lorensen of the 23rd Judicial Circuit.

This matter was investigated by the Martinsburg City Police Department and prosecuted by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Raymond E. Boyce, Jr. Ms. Delligatti would like to specifically thank PFC Ryan Fritz, the investigating officer in this matter, both for his service to the community generally as well as for his dedication to drug interdiction specifically, and the jury for carefully weighing the evidence and providing a verdict that achieves justice on behalf of the community.
