Indictments Returned By the February, 2020 Term of the Berkeley County Grand Jury

MARTINSBURG, WV – Berkeley County Prosecuting Attorney Catie Wilkes Delligatti announces that on Tuesday, February 18, 2020, the February 2020 term of Grand Jury was convened at the Berkeley County Judicial Center. Grand Jury deliberations lasted through Friday. The Grand Jury returned a total of sixty-one (61) indictments.

Indictments were returned against the following individuals for the following counts.

DEANA ALBRECHT aka DEANA ABRECHT, 21, of Luray, Virginia, was charged with First Degree Murder, Conspiracy to Commit First Degree Murder, and Use of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony.

BONI FACIO ARAMBURO, 35, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with two counts of Third Offense Driving While License Revoked for DUI, Fleeing From a Law Enforcement Officer in a Vehicle, and Possession of a Controlled Substance (Marijuana).

RICHARD CLEMMONS AUSTIN, 34, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Murder and Attempted Murder.

KAYLA MARIE BOWERS, 29, of Inwood, West Virginia, was charged with Wanton Endangerment, Domestic Assault, and Domestic Battery.

BRANDON MICHAEL BROWN, 32, of Hedgesville, West Virginia, was charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Methamphetamine and Conspiracy to Possession with Intent to Deliver Methamphetamine.

MICHAEL PHILLIP BROWNING, 46, of Kearneysville, West Virginia, was charged with Murder, Burglary, Robbery 1st Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, Conspiracy to Commit Burglary, and Felony Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.

CLAYFORD DAVID BURGOS, 32, of Wilmington, Delaware, was charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin and Possession with Intent to Deliver Crack Cocaine.

STEPHEN PATRICK BUSH, 32 of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with four counts of Sexual Abuse by Parent, Guardian or Custodian or Person in a Position of Trust and two counts of Sexual Abuse in the Third Degree.

JAMES HAROLD BUTTS, 49, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with four counts of Wanton Endangerment.

DIANE CAMPBELL, 65, of Inwood, West Virginia, was charged with Felony Fraudulent Scheme, two counts of Forgery, and two counts of Uttering.

DYLAN JACOB CHAMBERS, 29, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Distribution of Fentanyl.

DONTA JERMAINE CHILDS, 30, of no fixed address, was charged with Fleeing from a Law Enforcement Officer with Reckless Indifference, Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana, and Prohibited Person in Possession of a Firearm.

JUSTIN TROY CLARK, 27, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Cocaine Base, Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin, and Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine.

WILLIAM FREEMAN, 29, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Conspiracy to Violate Possession of Contraband in Jail by an Inmate, Conspiracy to Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin, Conspiracy to Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine, Attempted Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin, Attempted Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine, Attempted Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana, and three counts of Attempted Possession of a Controlled Substance in Jail by an Inmate.

ANTHONY JACINTO GONZALES, 27, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Distribution of Heroin and Distribution of Crack Cocaine.

WENDELL GREENE, 58, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Delivery of Crack Cocaine and Driving Revoked for DUI.

WILLIAM DALTON GREEN, 26, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Soliciting a Minor via a Computer, and Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana.

MATTHEW SEAN HENSON, 22, of Falling Waters, West Virginia, was charged with Filming Sexually Explicit Conduct with a Minor, Distribution of Child Pornography, Sexual Assault in the 2nd Degree and Sexual Assault in the Third Degree.

NASHAUN MALICK HOWARD, 18, of Washington, D.C., was charged with First Degree Murder, Conspiracy to Commit First Degree Murder, and Use of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony.

CHRISTOPHER DUANE JACKSON, 42, of Harpers Ferry, West Virginia, was charged with Murder, Burglary, Robbery 1st Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, and Conspiracy to Commit Burglary.

BROOKLYN ZAVION JOHNSON, 15, of Washington, D.C., was charged with First Degree Murder, Conspiracy to Commit First Degree Murder, and Use of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony.

EMILY J. KEEFER aka EMILY J. COOK, 20, of Berkeley Springs, West Virginia, was charged with Conspiracy to Violate Possession of Contraband in Jail by an Inmate, Conspiracy to Possession with Intent to Deliver Buprenorphine, Bribery (Accepting Bribe), and Transporting a Controlled Substance into Jail.

DALE EDWARD KNIGHT, 33, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Felony Escape and Misdemeanor Destruction of Property.

ROBERT LANDIS KRAMERAGE, 38, of Kearneysville, West Virginia, was charged Murder, Burglary, Robbery 1st Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, and Conspiracy to Commit Burglary, and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.

DEVEN ROBEY, 23, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with two counts of Distribution of Eutylone and two counts of Conspiracy to Distribution of Eutylone.

STEVEN EUGENE ROGERS, JR., 26, of Gerrardstown, West Virginia, was charged with Grand Larceny.

JOSHUA LEE RUNKLES, 35, of Hedgesville, West Virginia, was charged with Distribution of Heroin and Conspiracy to Distribute Heroin.

DELBERT CORNELIUS SHEPPARD, 56, of Kearneysville, West Virginia, was charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver Crack Cocaine.

VIRGINIA ANN SIMMS, 38, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Grand Larceny, Burglary, Misdemeanor Destruction of Property, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, First Offense.

GARY R. STATLER, JR. aka CHIP STATLER, 46, of Hedgesville, West Virginia, was charged four counts of Delivery of L.S.D.

RICKY LEE STAUBS, 30, of Hedgesville, West Virginia, was charged with two counts of Third Offense Driving While License Revoked for DUI, and Providing False Information to Law Enforcement Officer.

CALEB PAUL TEBEAU, 16, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with Possession with three counts of Sexual Assault in the First Degree, two counts of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree, and four counts of Sexual Abuse by Parent, Guardian, Custodian, or Person in a Position of Trust.

JENNIFER NICOLE THOMAS, 32, of Martinsburg, West Virginia, was charged with First Degree Murder, Conspiracy to Commit First Degree Murder, and Use of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony.

MICHAEL ANTHONY VOGES, 29, of Kearneysville, West Virginia, was charged with Distribution of Fentanyl.

All charges contained in the above-referenced indictments are merely accusations and not evidence of guilt. Each defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
