MARTINSBURG, W. Va. – Berkeley County Prosecuting Attorney Catie Wilkes Delligatti announces that a Berkeley County jury found ROBERT LANDIS KRAMERAGE, 39, of Kearneysville, West Virginia, guilty of the felony offenses of First Degree Murder, Burglary, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, Conspiracy to Commit Burglary, and Person Prohibited from Possession of a Firearm arising from the March 9, 2019 shooting death of Joshua Case.

The four day trial was held before the Honorable Judge Bridget Cohee and the jury returned a verdict of guilty on all counts on Friday, April 30, 2021. On Monday, May 3, 2021 the jury returned to hear evidence regarding the Defendant's life sentence and whether he would be eligible for parole. During the afternoon hours, the jury returned a verdict recommending that the Defendant be sentenced to Life Without Mercy, meaning that he will not be eligible for parole. A formal Sentencing Hearing has been scheduled before the Honorable Judge Cohee to take place on June 10, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.

This matter was investigated by the West Virginia State Police, with assistance from the Eastern Panhandle Drug and Violent Crimes Task Force, and prosecuted by Prosecuting Attorney Catie Wilkes Delligatti and Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Joseph Kinser.

Ms. Delligatti would like to specifically thank F/Sgt. J.M. Walker and Sgt. D.S. See of the West Virginia State Police for their dedicated efforts in this investigation, and note her appreciation for the resources of the Task Force which were vital in solving this violent crime. Ms. Delligatti would also like to thank the jury for carefully weighing the evidence and providing a verdict that achieves justice for those close to Mr. Case and the community.
